

# Dining Hall Rules

During your stay meals will be served in our camp Dining Hall. Please arrive to meals on-time as our kitchen has limited serving hours. Shirts and footwear MUST be worn inside the dining hall at all times!

Help us ensure a smooth meal service by following the outlined procedures and expectations below.

**Mealtimes:** When meals are ready, you will hear a bell ring. Mealtimes are **7:30AM** for breakfast, **12:30PM** for lunch and **6:00PM** for dinner. Please enter through the side doors of the dining hall and wash your hands before entering. (There are wash sinks on both sides of the dining hall).

## Drink Stations:

There is a water bottle filling station on the *right side* of the dining hall veranda and a coffee/tea station for adults on the *left side*. There are also drink stations inside during meals.



## Dietary Restrictions:

It's important that the kitchen knows of any special diets ahead of time! For any dietary restrictions (*vegetarian, dairy-free, etc.*), please use our [online form](#) to be filled out by *each individual with a special diet*. Once at camp while in the serving line, please tell the servers that you need a special diets plate.

## Clean-Up After Yourself:

Please do your part to keep our dining hall clean! During mealtimes, you are expected to buss your own tables and wipe them down after eating, along with sweeping around your table and cleaning up any food messes. To reduce the number of Yellow Jackets (*bees*), we have relocated our trash cans and dirty dish station outside, past the wash sink on the right-side of the dining hall.

## Trash:

After finishing your meal, we require that all trash and food waste be sorted! ALL food waste (including meat and bones) go into the **green bins**. All other trash (*paper plates, napkins and disposable utensils*) should go into the **black bins**. Do NOT put paper towels or napkins in the green bins!
