

Required Forms

Please be advised that **ALL PARTICIPANTS** (both youth & adult) attending the weekend at Emerald Bay must turn in hard copies of their required weekend forms to their group leader or the Program Director before arrival to camp. Individuals who have not turned in their required weekend forms will be prevented from loading onto the boat to camp and will not be able to participate in any of the weekend activities!

We do not take electronic submissions for any forms, so please submit paper copies only!

REQUIRED WEEKEND FORMS

The following two forms are required by ALL participants attending Emerald Bay. Please ensure that your entire group has all of these forms ready to submit to the Program Director upon arrival to camp.

1. Health Forms:

The Scouting America's Annual Health and Medical Record form must be completed in its entirety for ALL Emerald Bay participants. Please ensure each individual has this form completed and has attained the required physician physical within 12 months of attendance.

2. Pre-Camp Release Forms:

**Please note there is a different release form for youth vs. adult participants.*

For the youth release form, this is to be signed by parents and/or guardians on behalf of the youth participant prior to their arrival in camp. This provides a firearms permission & release, consent to full program, agreement to follow all of camp's rules, and an exculpation & indemnity provision. The firearms section is required for all persons who wish to participate in any shooting sports activity.
